ur recently held "Parent and Teacher Meetings", 3rd April 2025 were well attended. On behalf of all South Lake Primary staff, thank you to all parents and carers that were able to make it for the interviews. We have received positive feedback from parents and carers, and staff noted that they now have a more complete understanding of their students as well as the hopes that parents have for their children.

SOCIAL MEDIA

ocial media always has the potential for negative or abusive interactions which can harm children and affect their judgement and personal growth. To combat this, social media has age restrictions that prevent children under a certain age from creating accounts.

The minimum age to open an account on Facebook, Twitter, Instagram, Pinterest, Tumblr, Kik, and Snapchat is 13. For Vine, Tinder and Yik Yak it's 17. YouTube requires account holders to be 18, but a 13-year-old can sign up with a parent's permission. Despite these clearly stated and published age restrictions, we are hearing about growing numbers of children 12 and under using social media networks, after school hours. Without proper guidance, children may make

public posts and *overshare personal information*, which can lead to them being harassed and at risk from malicious people. Children may also experience <u>cyberbullying</u>, and not just from their peers. However, regardless of their age, it's important to have a discussion with your child about how social media works and the nature of the images that they see in other people's lives, to ensure that they don't develop unhealthy ideas about their self-image.

eSafetyparents tip: Let you child know they can come to you for help if anything makes them feel uncomfortable or unsafe and they won't be in trouble. You can help them report serious online abuse to the Australian eSafety Commissioner
