## ONLINE SAFETY AND WELLBEING FOR CHILDREN: ADVICE FOR PARENTS

"Safe on Social" is a resource and an organization that provides information and guidance on online safety, including for platforms like **Roblox**. Roblox is considered dangerous for children due to risks of exposure to inappropriate content, cyberbullying, sexual predators, and the potential for addiction. The platform's open nature and user-generated content mean children can encounter violent or explicit material, interact with unknown adults, and be targeted with grooming attempts. While Roblox has implemented safety features and parental controls, these may not be sufficient to prevent all risks. While Roblox has built-in safety features like chat filtering, age-based restrictions, and parental controls, the "Safe on Social" perspective emphasises that parental supervision and ongoing communication are still critical for ensuring a child's safety due to hidden risks and the limitations of the platform's controls.

### "Safe on Social" and parental guidance

- Constant vigilance is necessary: Despite Roblox's safety features, "Safe on Social" highlights that parental supervision is essential because the platform is not completely risk-free and contains "hidden dangers".
- Communication is key: The "Safe on Social" approach, based on the ACE acronym, stresses the importance of Awareness, Communication, and Engagement.
  - Awareness: Be aware of what your child is doing online, not just on Roblox.
  - Communication: Have ongoing conversations with your child about their online activities, including who they interact with and the content they see.
  - Engagement: Be involved in their online world to the point where they feel comfortable coming to you with any concerns.
- Understand the limitations: Parents should understand that parental controls have limitations and cannot block every inappropriate game or interaction.
